

Spa-aah Day Wash Cloth

Ready to be pampered? What's better than an at home spa, with a luscious cloth you've made for yourself? Making things for yourself is truly a pleasure, but if you want to gift it consider pairing it with a small batch, hand crafted sugar scrub too.

To get started

You will need a 4.5mm crochet hook (size 7), approximately 50grams of worsted weight cotton for main colour, a small amount of same cotton in a contrasting colour, and a tapestry needle for weaving in ends.

I love Shine cotton from Knitpicks.com for this project due to it's softness and sheen.

US Terms

Sl st – slip stitch

Ch – chain

Sp – space

Hdc – half double crochet

Sc – single crochet

Directions

Make your foundation chain with 41 chains.

Row 1 – Sc in 3rd ch from hook, *ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch*, repeat from * to * until you reach the end. Sc in last ch of foundation. Turn

Row 2 – Ch 2, hdc in 1st ch sp, *(ch1, skip next sc, hdc in next ch sp*, repeat from * to * until you reach the end. Should end with a hdc. Turn

Row 3 – Ch 1, sc in 1st ch sp, * ch1, skip next hdc, sc in next ch sp*, repeat from * to * until you reach the end. Should end with a sc. Turn

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until you make a square – approximately 9 inches from the start. End with a sc row.

Border – add contrasting colour and sc evenly around entire piece.

When you reach corners, ch 3 to create space for a nice corner in next round. Sl st to first ch of round.

– ch1, (1sc, ch3, 1sc) in base of ch1, * skip 2sc, (1sc, ch3, 1sc) in next sc, * repeat from * to * around cloth to end, sl st to first sc. Fasten off, weave in ends with tapestry needle and trim loose ends of yarn.
